CRETE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

April 8, 2020

The regular scheduled meeting of the Crete Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Liccar at 7:11 PM.

This meeting is very historical. Due to the Shelter in policy enacted by the Governor of Illinois, Supervisor Liccar organized a Zoom Conference Call/Video to have the regularly scheduled monthly Crete Township Board of Directors meeting.

Board members present were Trustee Elton, Trustee Hodge, Trustee Piacentini, Trustee Grady and Supervisor Liccar. Clerk Buiter was also present.

Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2020 Board of Trustees meeting was made by Trustee Elton, seconded by Trustee Hodge. All were in favor, minutes stand approved as written.

REPORTS:

Supervisor

Supervisor Liccar stated that PACE continues to provide paratransit services in this environment. A lot of the passengers are at risk. The average ride per day was 7 rides which was well below the normal average. PACE has been providing a lot of hand sanitizers and other precautions to protect the riders from COVID 19 virus.

Supervisor Liccar mentioned that we are following Governor's Shelter In Order so the Township building will be closed to the public till April 30, 2020. The elected and appointed officials will have access as well as employees of the Township. In addition, the Township Food Pantry will be delivering food to citizens via a drive through area in the general parking lot. A motion was made to limit the accessibility of the Township building for the general public through April 30, 2020 and the elected officials and staff follow the social distancing when they come in to do their responsibilities by Trustee Piacentini, second by Trustee Hodge All were in favor. Roll Call was as follows: Trustee Elton – yes; Trustee Hodge – yes; Trustee Grady – yes; Trustee Piacentini – yes; Supervisor Liccar – yes.

Motion was made to hold the Budget Workshop meeting on April 15, 2020 and April 29, 2020 at 1:00 PM via Zoom Conference Video by Frank Elton and seconded by Trustee Hodge. Trustee Elton – yes; Trustee Hodge- yes, Trustee Piacentini – yes, Trustee Grady – yes; Supervisor Liccar - yes. The motion carries.

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Supervisor Liccar contacted our attorney to take care of the garbage piling up on a citizen's property from a neighbor's property. The attorney said we must get a court order to enter or take any action on someone's property. Supervisor Liccar suggested we do nothing, and he will keep the other trustees posted.

Clerk: The Annual Township meeting has been postponed till further notice. passed.

Highway Commissioner- Supervisor Recupito read his report. Equipment maintenance is ongoing. Roads are being plowed and salted properly. Roads are being cold patch. Signs are being replaced. Bucket Truck Lift was safety inspected. See Attached written report of activity.

Plan Commission – John Rzymiski attended a Chicago Southland meeting at Bult's Field and he doubts there will be any activity this year from a project standpoint.

Building and Grounds – Trustee Hodge reported that the RING security system was installed and there is now an outside mailbox.

Senior Transportation – Supervisor Liccar gave the report as noted above.

Youth – Trustee Piantentini mentioned The Crete Park District is having social distance Egg Hunt this weekend.

Mosquito Abatement – It was mentioned that the Trustee Piacentini stated the pickup truck recall was done. It was mentioned that Bob the driver calls all the people who have breathing and informs that he is spraying, and the citizens are very thankful. Trustee Piacenitini and Bob the driver has been certified to the mosquito abatement till December 31, 2020.

Senior & Special Events – Trustee Elton stated everything is on hold so no plans yet with the Shelter in Place edict
